

Sample SOP for Visitor Visa Canada **After Refusal**

Statement of Purpose

To The Visa Officer High Commission of Canada

Sub: Application in response to visitor visa refused on 09/05/2022 (W306502373)

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am Jatin Mahal, an Indian national bearing passport number T9065958, thank you for allowing me to represent my case one more time. Through this application, I intend to bring to your kind notice that I want to visit my beloved wife in Canada who is pursuing a Graduate Certificate in Healthcare Management from Cape Breton University which will conclude by <add year>. Since she left for Canada in <add year>, we have been living apart and filling the emotional gap through voice-over calls, video conferencing, chats, emails, or messages. However, at the end of each day, we find each other physically distant which is emotionally draining. Although I am equally thankful to the technology for providing us with the privilege to at least see or talk to each other over VOIP. With a heavy heart, I admit that I have been missing her so dearly and vice versa. We never thought that it would be so emotionally exhausting for both of us. Hence, to comfort her and do equal justice to my feelings, I have decided to visit her in person and stay by her side while she continues her study program and other endeavours. Unfortunately, my previous visa application was rejected due to the following reasons:

- I am not satisfied that you will leave Canada at the end of your stay, as stipulated in subsection 200(1) of the IRPR, based on your immigration status.

Purpose of visit

I am a qualified mechanical engineer who is also MBA qualified and possess great working exposure in engineering products, product management and sales and marketing. I am temporarily residing in the UAE for the fulfillment of my professional duties. My work visa will expire in November 2022 which gives me the impetus to utilize my time and spend it with my beloved wife who is homesick in a foreign land. However, due to my esteemed qualifications and work experience, I am sure that I would not pose any liability either to my wife or Canada. I will be able to find myself a decent part-time opportunity to keep



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myself busy as well as earn my living expenses, rather liberate my wife so she can purely focus on her studies and not have to do any part-time job. However, I am aiming to visit Canada only to support my wife and I do not see my future in this country due to having the joint goal of settling with my wife in India permanently.
