## Sample SOP for LLM

I also worked with Khera Associates and Advocates, where I visited the courts, researched various parameters of the Hindu Marriage Act, and even observed a hearing on the Indian Arbitration Act.

From the internship experiences I have gained requisite practical knowledge; however, I now believe that for a stronger hold of the various laws I need to plunge back into studies and acquire extensive knowledge of particular domains so I can master them. I will be happy to attain this knowledge from the university's
