I have been accepted into St. Columbus University for a Bachelor's in Business Administration for the upcoming winter intake of November 2025. I am sharing all the relevant details like academic background, family ties, financial details, and future goals which are mandatory.

### Cover Letter

I have been an academically average student with extra engagement in sports and extracurricular activities in the early years of school. I completed my secondary and senior secondary school from CBSE and PSEB boards respectively. In 2021, I passed secondary school with 63% marks and I knew that this was a satisfactory performance and that if I worked hard; I could certainly perform better. So, I dedicated myself to my studies for the next two years. My hard work paid off when I scored 96% in my senior secondary school examinations and made my family proud of me.
